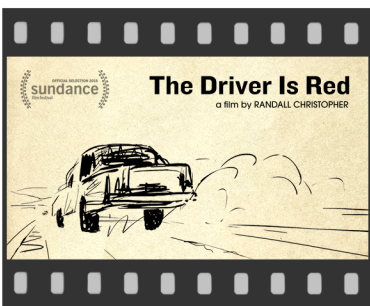

Rose Schindler (b. 1929) Born and raised in Czechoslovakia, Rose was deported to Auschwitz along with her parents, aunt, five sisters and two brothers when she was just 14 years old. As one capable of providing a first-hand account of the horror of the Holocaust, she remains steadfast and determined to offer the incomparable opportunity to meet a survivor. Her new memoir *Two Who Survived* was published earlier this year and will be available at the event.



The talk will be preceded by a screening of the animated short *The Driver Is Red*. Set in 1960, the film recounts the true story of secret agent Zvi Aharoni as he tracked down one of the highest ranking Nazi war criminals on the run. An official selection of Sundance and over 100 other film festivals, *The Driver Is Red* has won 42 festival awards to date. Director Randall Christopher will present the film.
